Living Your Legacy Essay

In 1926, a Harvard scholar by the name of Dr. Carter G. Woodson organized the first annual Negro History Week. The said event happened on the second week of February which also coincides with the birthdays of two great civil rights leaders - Abraham Lincoln and Frederick Douglass.

Entry Period: All entries must be received by 3:45 PM (ET) April 20, 2010 and must comply with the rules listed on the scholarship application. Applications will be available on February 16, 2010 at the Band Booster Meeting and in the Band Office.

Eligibility: This scholarship is open to current senior band members of the Highland Springs High School (all ensembles).

To Enter: Complete the scholarship application and submit supporting documents by the deadline. The essay must constitute a completely original work by the Entrant.

Recipient Selection/Notification: One (1) recipient will be selected based on the highest number of points received during the review process. The scholarship recipient will be announced at the Band's Spring Awards Banquet.

Band Memorial Scholarship Award

INTRODUCTION

The Memorial Scholarship may be presented annually by the Highland Springs High School Band Booster Organization in memory of a band member, Michael Tatem, May 21, 1988 – June 22, 2007.

A non-renewable award of \$350.00 may be awarded to one (1) Highland Springs High School graduating band senior, who will be attending a higher learning institution. This award will be sent directly to the college or university finance office, by the Highland Springs High School Band Booster Organization, to be applied towards college expenses during the recipients' freshman year.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Be a Highland Springs High School band senior with a 2.5 GPA or higher.
2. Committed to enrolling in a college, university or other higher learning institution.
3. Provide three letters of recommendation. One must be from the student's high school band director, one from a school administrator or counselor, and one from an academic teacher.
4. Submit "Living Your Legacy" essay highlighting what you are doing to make the world a better place.
5. Provide a current copy of his/her high school transcript (through the first semester of the current school year), including SAT or ACT scores if available.
6. Has been a member of their high school band program for at least two years of high school.
7. The applicants' parents must be a current member of the Highland Springs High School Band Booster Organization.
8. Provide a copy of college acceptance letter, if available.
9. Application must be received by April 20, 2010.

APPLICATION

The Band Scholarship Committee will review the applications. The name of the recipient will be announced at the band's spring awards banquet. The band director will be notified of the committee's decision prior to the banquet.

Applications will be available in the Band Office and at the Band Booster Meetings (third Tuesdays). Return completed application and all related materials to: Charles Holland, President, 804-928-2531.

PAYMENT PROCEDURE

The Band Booster Organization will distribute the \$350.00 award on behalf of the recipient after their college enrollment. It will be the responsibility of each recipient to notify the Band Booster Organization of his/her enrollment. Students must also provide their Student Account Number or Social Security Number. The scholarship award will not be held for more than two (2) years from the date of the initial award.

Once the award check has been issued and the recipient fails to attend a higher learning institution, all scholarship funds must be reverted back to the Band Booster Organization, where it will be held for the same period of two (2) years as stated above, in the recipient's name.
